



**ESB 5127-Jobs Now Act Section 313-Chehalis River Basin Flood Relief Projects
Review and Approval Form**

(Prepared for Flood Authority Action on 8/30/2012)

Proposed Project: Burger King Trail/Dike (Preliminary Engineering Design, Costing Stage).

Lead Agency: City of Aberdeen.

Budget: \$24,600.

Description: The Burger King property is located between the Whiskas and the Heron street bridges. Extreme high water can top the bank and flood the adjacent commercial property. A small dike or elevated walkway along the river would help keep the river in its banks. The proposed project is listed in the City of Aberdeen's Public Works Master Project List (January 2011) and would be located on an easement on upland ground specifically obtained for the project. Need is for preliminary engineering design, costing. See project location at <http://goo.gl/maps/P9RBC>.

Flood Hazard Reduction Benefits: The dike/levee project prevents flood waters from entering important commercial areas and properties within the city limits of Aberdeen.

Adverse Impacts/Effects: Since water levels in the area are largely tidally influenced, the loss of floodplain storage due to these projects is considered negligible.

Project Feasibility: The scope and scale of the proposed project does not at this time appear to raise any significant issues that would likely preclude the project from moving forward.

Timeline: Identified next stage design work will begin for the proposed project soon after receipt of Jobs Now Act funding.

Authority: ESB5127, §313(2).

Jobs Supported: 0.1 FTE (for this stage).

Studies Completed: Unknown.

Further Studies Needed: Studies and documentation necessary to support permitting and environmental review.

Current Project Status: Waiting for funding.
