

North Shore Levee

Project Description/Overview:



- Construct a levee and stormwater conveyance improvements east of the Hoquiam River, north of Grays Harbor, and west of the Wishkah River
- Accredit levee and revise flood zone from Zone AE to Zone X
- Reduce or eliminate flooding and eliminate mandatory flood insurance requirements




Current Status:

- Surveying, hydraulic modeling, and geotechnical exploration in progress or complete
- Public outreach, neighborhood meetings, and open houses in progress
- Preferred alignment identified
- Consultation with Quinault Indian Nation (QIN) in progress
- Coordination with railroads in progress
- Funding up through 100% design secured through the Flood Authority
 - Preliminary design and Conditional Letter of Map Revision (CLOMR) package – \$988,000
 - Final design \$1,500,000





Upcoming Planned Activities:



- Neighborhood meetings: December 6, 2016
- Public open house:
 6 PM, December 6, 2016 at the Log Pavilion in Aberdeen
- Continued coordination with QIN, the railroads, and property owners
- Complete preliminary design spring 2017
- Obtain CLOMR summer 2017
- Finalize construction funding strategy and secure funds
- Final design begins summer 2017



Potential Issues:

- Private property impacts short-term and long-term
- Construction within railroad right-of-way
- Designing to the 500-year storm
- Planning for sea level rise
- Local funding
