Note: As recommended by the consultant, Jim Kramer, with the consent of the Flood Authority, the PSA approved by the Board of County Commissioners, associated with Res. 18-095, will be rescinded by Lewis County. That amount (\$85,000) will be re-appropriated as directed by the Flood Authority.

Note: With the recommendation of the Flood Authority, Res. 18-178 approved the Fifteenth Supplement to the PSA with West Consultants, to resurvey and reset gage datums on three gages. The Fifteenth Supplement increased the West PSA by \$8,625.00, resulting in a total contract amount not to exceed \$67,297 ending Dec. 31, 2018.
