Note: BOCC passed resolution #18-285, authorizing the sixteenth supplement to West's PSA. This resolution increases West's agreement by \$41,850 for Flood Warning Communication Improvements. Resolution #18-284 was also passed authorizing the ninth supplement to the French PSA. This resolution increases French's agreement by \$21,000 for expansion of CRS assistance.
