**SUBJECT:** Flood Authority Contracts (3/01/2018 through 6/30/2019)

The purpose of this memo is to seek the Flood Authority's approval for Lewis County to move forward to implement consultant funding agreements for the period March 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019 as described below. ## <u>Background</u>

- 2017-19 Flood Authority consultant scopes of work were approved by the Flood Authority at their June 15, 2017 meeting (see here <u>https://www.ezview.wa.gov/Portals/\_1492/images/6%20Proposed%20Consultants%20SOWs%20--</u> <u>%2006142017.pdf</u>)
- 2. Due to the substantially delayed 2017-19 State Capital Budget, Lewis County (acting as fiscal agent for the Flood Authority) had to incrementally implement these scopes of work through shorter duration funding agreements.
- 3. Now that a 2017-19 State Capital Budget is in place, Lewis County needs to implement remaining funding agreements for the period March 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019 (16 months).

## <u>Decision</u>

Does the Flood Authority approve Lewis County moving forward to implement funding contracts for the remining March 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019 (16 months) time period as follows:

** Note: Total funding for the period March 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019 will not cause the total for the biennium to exceed the Flood Authority's original authorization of \$380,000.
