Call for Projects

QUADCO—Kittitas, Lincoln, Grant, and Adams Coordinated Public Transit-Human Services Transportation Plan

Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) has released the Public Transportation Grant Application for July 1, 2017 to June 30, 2019. You may access the grant forms and information at www.wsdot.wa.gov/transit.

The Federal Transit Authority requires the establishment of a locally developed, coordinated Human Service Transportation Plans for special needs transportation programs. In addition, WSDOT requires that all applicants for the Consolidated Grant Program participate in the planning process with their local Regional Transportation Planning Organization (RTPO). All projects must come from the needs and strategies identified in the Human Service Transportation Plan. In addition to the planning requirement, all projects must be submitted for prioritization and ranking. (*Please review Appendix C of the WSDOT Public Transportation Consolidated Grant Application*).

Projects will be prioritized, ranked and approved by QUADCO RTPO based on the following criteria:

- **Preservation:** Ensure that current transportation resources that are effective and efficient are not eliminated or reduced.
- ➤ **Meet the Needs:** Transportation services need to meet the identified needs of the target population.
- **Coordination:** Assure non-duplication and coordination of existing transportation resources.
- **Effectiveness:** Transportation services need to be available, accessible and adaptable to meet the needs.
- ➤ Cost Efficiency: Identify cost efficiency by ridership, miles, and hours, but also by the ancillary savings and the return on investment. Providing transportation for individuals to become employed has a cost savings when compared to the cost of welfare.
