- Ecology = NPDES authority, issues CAFO permits










Current CAFO Permit Timeline




Working with the permit as currently written





One Permit, Two Options

Combined permit: surface and groundwater discharges



State permit: groundwater discharges only




Current Permit Coverage








Current Permit Coverage










Current CAFO Permit Timeline










Moving Forward
