



#### 2019 - 2021 Capital Budget - Conclusions

As of December 2018 - Governor's Capital Budget

- OCRs 19-21 capital budget = \$34.4 million.
- YBIPs 19-21 capital budget = \$31.5 million.
- YRBWEP 19-21 capital budget = \$4.2 million

TOTAL = \$70.1 million
