- Regulatory Program for Development/Redevelopment/Code
- Public Involvement, Education and Outreach
- Coordination with other municipalities
- Monitoring and Assessment

Monitoring


Wadeable Streams

- 9 index sites (every year)
- 42 rotating panel (every 5 years)
- No mainstem sites in East Fork, North Fork, or Washougal

East Fork Lewis River:

- 1 index site (Rock Creek North)
- 7 rotating panel sites (2019)
- Will include E. Coli starting in WY2019
- Some period of overlap with fecal coliform

Mapping and Inventory

Ditches and Stormwater Outfalls

- Included in Storm Sewer System
- Can transport pollutants (bacteria) to streams
- Update ditch and outfall mapping in East Fork during next permit term (2019-2024)

Road and Ditch Maintenance

- Regional Road Maintenance Forum
 - Endangered Species Act compliance
 - Approved operations methods to minimize fish impacts
 - Required training for maintenance crews

Stormwater Capital Improvements

- No stormwater facilities planned 2019–2024
- Property Acquisitions count toward municipal permit requirements
 - Legacy Lands acquisitions may be leveraged with Clean Water Division funds
