Description of proposal:

The Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) conducted a SEPA review on the environmental impacts associated with the collection of per- and polyfluoroalkyl substance-containing firefighting foam, and its transport and final disposal. Ecology accepted public comment on the SEPA checklist and determination for 30 days during the month of September 2020. Ecology's chosen disposal method was to incinerate the foam, however, public comments raised several issues that led Ecology to believe the current project involves unique and unknown risks to the environment, as well as downwind communities.
