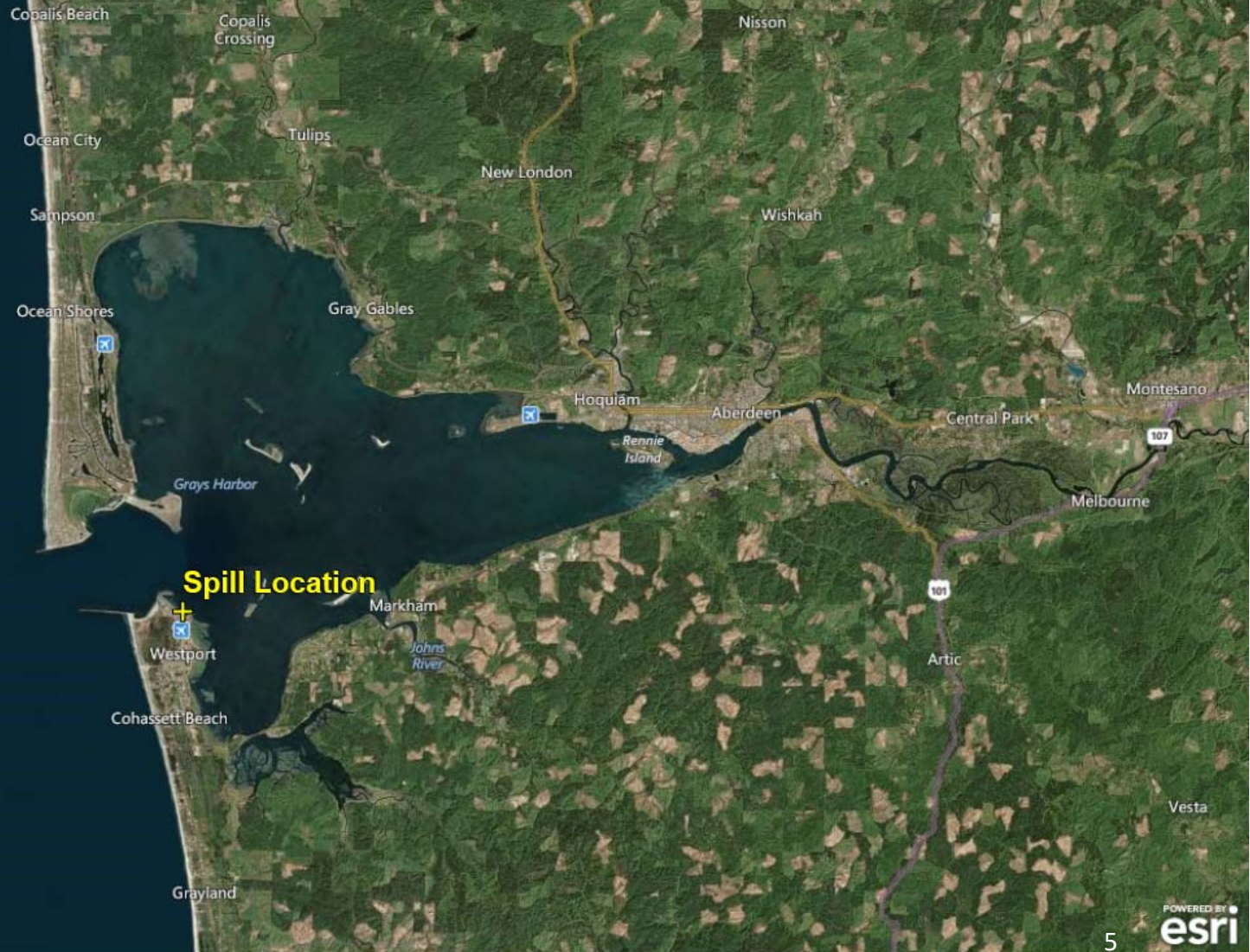

Deaton Lands LLC

March 1, 2015 waste oil spill into Sulphur Creek wetland and Yakima River
