



ERTS# 699262 P/C Grand Finale

July 7, 2020 diesel fuel spill into Gig Harbor














Initial Spill

- Volume of oil recovered: 36 gallons





ERTS# 655112 Deaton Land LLC

Approximately 2,700 gallons of oil was lost from the tank, 1,900 gallons of which damaged seven miles of Sulphur Creek and 12 miles of the Yakima River, from Mabton to Prosser, over four days.

	August 12, 2015	Preassessment Screening, trustees determine damages to be calculated using Compensation Schedule
Í	September 4, 2015	Received wetland rating from SEA Program, Ecology
I	October 22, 2015	Follow-up letter sent, clarifying case details
1	October 23, 2018	Deaton Land proposes Buena habitat improvement project
	January 9, 2019	RDA committee reviews project, determines that this project does not adequately compensate damages State and tribal trustees evaluate next steps, potential outcomes
I	February 6, 2019	Ecology informs Deaton Land of the decision Grants additional 30 days to identify a new project
Í	June 13, 2019	Wetland Compensation Schedule finalized
Í	June 20, 2019	Demand Letter issued by AAG
1	August 7, 2019	Deaton land proposes WDFW Sunnyside Snake River Wildlife Area wetland enhancement project
	August 14, 2019	RDA Committee reviews project, determines that this project does not adequately compensate damages
	October 2, 2019	Ecology informs Deaton Land of committee decision, issues second demand letter
I	October 23, 2019	Representation for Deaton Land responds, indicates that their client is unable to pay

Next steps

- If unable or unwilling to pay or settle, Ecology will open discussions with NPFC
 - Ecology and Yakama nation to bring the claim jointly.
 - The USFWS is not pursuing damages.
 - This claim will seek funding for a project identified by the RDA committee and Yakama Nation.
 - NRD claim valuation using the compensation schedule

 - Environmental injury and the compensation schedule
