





2021 Spills Coastal Protection Fund Grant Q4 update



Tarboo Creek Protection and Restoration – Radka Property Northwest Watershed Institute

- Conservation easement and stewardship plan completed.
- Restoration maintenance is on going, one more site visit scheduled.



Olaf Strad Remeander and Revegetation Adopt A Stream Foundation

- Channel construction and instream fish habitat construction complete.
- Project nearly finished.



Skagit Wetland Reconnection Skagit Fisheries Enhancement Group

- Half a mile of side channel installed, connecting Britt Slough, to a wetland, and into the South Fork Skagit River.
- SFEG, WCC, and volunteer crews finished initial planting, over
 5,500 native trees and shrubs.
- An estimated 20% of plants were lost to November 2021 floods.
 Supplemental planting to occur.

Skagit Fisheries Enhancement Group

- SFEG continues to prepare for 2022 planting.
- Mapped understory planting area, continued invasive weed control.



Milewa Creek Marine Shoreline Restoration Washington State Department of Fish and Wildlife




Mid-Columbia Fisheries Enhancement Group

- Restoration implementation complete.
 - In-stream modifications complete.
 - 1870 native trees and shrubs installed in the planting area.
 - One volunteer planting event conducted, two volunteer events to go
