Works lost traction and slid through an intersection and into Salmon Creek, northwest of Okanogan. An estimated 40 gallons of diesel spilled into the creek. The majority of the creek was iced over, preventing responders from recovering the spilled oil. County Roads, EMD, Sheriff's Department, and the local Fire District deployed sorbents to contain the oil and removed the plow from the creek. The following day, Okanogan County hired NRC-ES/US Ecology to recover as much oil as

possible.
