reported a hydraulic oil spill from a blown fish gear seal. At the time, an estimated 50-70 gallons of hydraulic oil was spilled to non-permeable containment. January 22, 2020, dam staff were pressure washing and noticed sheen in the waterway. They think it was caused by residual oil form the January 16 spill washing into the river. They estimate as much as 35 gallons was washed into the river. None of the oil was recovered.
