**Incident Summary:** On December 8, 2020, the United States Army Corps of Engineers

reported an oil sheen in the locks of the John Day Dam in the Columbia River. Further investigation by the Army Corps revealed that the spill came from a pinhole leak in a turbine guide bearing sump. The Army Corps estimates 63 gallons of turbine oil spilled as a result of the bearing failure. None of the oil was recovered within the first 24 hours of the

spill.
