Incident Summary:	On August 7, 2021, the 41-foot, wooden-hulled, P/C Hobo grounded on a submerged portion of the North Jetty of the Columbia River entrance near Ilwaco. The vessel began flooding, and despite attempted assistance from USCG patrol boats, the vessel had to be grounded on Waikiki Beach at Cape Disappointment State Park to prevent it from sinking. The vessel was significantly damaged in the surf overnight, loosing most of its diesel fuel, and was subsequently dismantled on the beach. Of the estimated 170 gallons of diesel aboard at the time to the grounding, only about 17 gallons was recovered the next day from its fuel tanks with the remaining 153 lost to the beach and water.
