Incident Summary:	On August 27, 2022, the Everett Fire Department reported a 31' cabin cruiser partially sank at the Port of Everett Marina. Everett Fire, Ecology and the USCG responded to the vessel. The vessel appeared to be leaking gasoline from fuel vents. The total fuel capacity is 800 gallons, however the vessel owner estimated that about 300 gallons of gasoline was aboard when it sank. Ecology worked with the vessel owner to identify a salvage company to raise the vessel. Ultimately the Port of Everett opted to hire US-Ecology to remediate the pollution risk. On August 29, 2022, US- Ecology plugged the vents and defueled the vessel. The defueled vessel remains submerged in its slip at the Port of Everett Marina.
