Incident Summary:	On October 24, 2022, the United States Army Corps of Engineers reported an estimated 600 gallons of turbine oil leaked into the Snake River over the course of three months. The Army Corps has not observed any visible oil sheen in the river as a result of this spill event. Upon discovering the spill, environmental staff from the Army Corps searched for downstream impacts and did not observe any oil sheen between the Little Goose Dam and the Lower Monumental Dam. The leaking turbine has been taken offline until further notice as the investigation continues. None of the oil was recovered from the water in the first 24-hours of the spill.
