Incident Summary:	On December 6, 2022, staff at the McNeil Island Special Commitment Center notified Ecology of a 130-gallon mineral oil spill from a transformer into a nearby pond connected to Luhr Creek on McNeil Island. The spill occurred in the evening of December 6, when an unknown individual damaged an unused ground transformer while apparently attempting to steal the copper pipes. The transformer spilled 130 gallons of non-PCB mineral oil, and an estimated 40-gallons of which spilled to the pond and creek. None of the oil was recovered in the initial 24-hours of the spill.
