A team of "Partners" with tribal back grounds and experience that understand brownfields issues in a tribal context.









TAB Assistance & Training to Nations/Tribes

- Free assistance to the Tribal Response Program (TRP) brownfields efforts
 - Coordinated through the tribal TRP-Brownfields coordinator or Environmental Program Manager.
- Requests for assistance accepted on a 'first come' basis
 - Depends on KSU TAB staff/funding availability






